COMMENT

Word:

*The flag of my cross is the flag of freedom.
My cross brings freedom to you - freedom to live and walk with me.*

Bible base:

John 8:32 “Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free.”

Comment:

God loves this land, and wants to give freedom to his people. The world has given bondage and suffering. God knows all about this. He grieves for what has happened. But he has a precious gift for his people - freedom in the Spirit

Word:

The enemy comes to destroy your freedom, to crush you to grind you into the dust.

Bible base:

John 10:10 “The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy.”

Comment:

This has always been the intention of the enemy - to destroy God’s people. As the ice cap came down and crushed the land, so the enemy wants to crush the people of God. He wants to wipe out their memory, and establish his triumph.

Word:

But he has no power or right to do this, because I shelter you under the shadow of my cross.

Bible base:

John 8:44 “You belong to your father, the devil, and you want to carry out your father’s desire. He was a murderer from the beginning, not holding to the truth, for there is no truth in him. When he lies, he speaks his native language, for he is a liar and the father of lies.”

Comment:

The enemy has no power, except that which God allows. The enemy tries to fool us, by telling us he has power and authority over us. Authority belongs to Jesus, and to him alone. This authority was bought at a terrible price, but it guarantees our safety, our protection and our victory.

Word:

*Draw closer to that cross now. Come – for I am calling you.
I will protect you, because you are mine, bought with the blood of the cross.*

Bible base:

Psalm 91:1 “He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High will rest in the shadow of the Almighty.”

Comment:

God looks for one thing – that we draw close to him. We need have no fear of him, for he loves us, and longs to protect and encourage us. We do not need to bring anything - the price has been paid.

It is so easy, when we get beaten down and defeated over so many years to hesitate to come close. We feel unworthy, worthless, and have become so used to being beaten, that we expect it again and again.

This will not happen. God calls. He only waits for us to come, and he will pour out his love on us.

Word:

You are few, but I love you, and have plans for blessing you.

Bible base:

Rev 34:8 “I know your deeds. See, I have placed before you an open door, that no one can shut. I know that you have little strength, yet you have kept my word and not denied my name.”

Comment:

Size has never mattered to God. The only thing that does matter is a love for him and a longing to serve him. When we have this mind, he will pour out his blessing on us.
